## UN3373/Exempt Specimens/Dry Ice as SPD

Effective June 1, 2010, United Express carrier Colgan Air will begin to accept dry ice in quantities up to 5.5 pounds in SPD small package shipments. The chart below listing UA and UAX carrier regulations governing the acceptance of UN 3373: Biological Substance – Category B, exempt human and animal patient specimens and dry ice as SPDs has been modified to reflect Colgan’s policies and to reflect modifications in other United Express carrier’s policies.

<sup>2</sup> Package must be packed, labeled and the air waybill marked according to IATA regulations for UN3373.

<sup>3</sup> This category includes blood and organs intended for human or animal transfusion or transplant; and human or animal samples transported for routine testing not related to the diagnosis of an infectious disease.

<sup>4</sup> - Up to 5.5 pounds of dry ice per package is accepted in SPDs at a UA passenger terminal.

- Up to 50 pounds of dry ice per package is accepted in SPDs at UA SPD Centers in LAX, ORD and SFO, if the commodity being cooled is a “medical shipment” and is not dangerous goods.

- Up to 99 pounds of dry ice per package is accepted in SPDs tendered at a UA freight facility. If the commodity being cooled is dangerous goods, DG marking and paperwork requirements apply.

<sup>5</sup> The combined weight of dry ice in all cargo bins on S5 flights may not exceed 77 pounds per aircraft.
